You may be tempted to park at unsafe locations, such as on the shoulder of the road, exit ramps, or vacant lots, if you are unable to locate official, available parking. Don't do it. Those days are gone.

LOTO (Lockout Tagout)

Anytime you operate, clean, service, adjust, or repair equipment you should be aware of the hazards associated with that machinery. Any powered machinery or electrical equipment that can move in a way that would put you in danger is a hazard that can be prevented by following LOTO procedures. Failure to lock out or tag power sources on equipment can result in electrocutions, amputations, and other serious-sometimes fatal-accidents.

I know that sometimes the delivery man will get something in the wrong place, but that is usually because the rack markers with your name have been moved or removed.
